One recent example involved a case in which FWY represented a middle-aged woman who, presenting to her doctor's office with flu-like symptoms, was administered a sample of a drug which adversely reacted with a subscription medication she had already been taking. This led to a rather complex medical chain of events which ultimately resulted in her sodium levels first decreasing to dangerously low levels and then being too rapidly stabilized. This in turn caused swelling of FWY's client's brain stem and, in turn, a number of debilitating symptoms. After several years of litigation the defendant refused to offer anything in settlement of the case. The case proceeded to trial in MA Superior Court against the nurse who administered the sample of the offending medication. After several days of trial the case settled for several hundred thousand dollars after FWY's cross examination of one of the defense's primary medical witnesses, who the defense had called out of order over FWY's objection.
